EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 030-2019

AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE MUNICIPAL PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL (MPOC) OF PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO

WHEREAS, the Municipal Peace and Order Council (MPOC) was created in compliance with Executive Order No. 309 series of 1998 and Section 116 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, Memorandum Circular No. 2015-130 of the Department of Interior and Local Government was issued on November 3, 2015 which provided guidelines on the function of the Peace and Order Councils to strengthen the Peace and Order Councils pursuant to the Peace and Development Agenda;

WHEREAS, there is a need to reconstitute the council to update its membership and replace members who no longer represent the agency or organization due to retirement or end of term.

Section 1. COMPOSITION. The Municipal Peace and Order Council shall be composed of the following:

The Composition of the MPOC shall be by office or sector represented by its incumbent official/representative.

Section 2. FUNCTION & DUTIES. The MPOC shall have the following duties and functions:

1. Provide a forum for interdisciplinary dialogue and deliberation of major issues and problems and concerns affecting peace, order and public safety nationwide;
2. Recommend strategic actions or activities aimed at promoting, improving or enhancing peace, order and public safety measures, including anti-insurgency measures;



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3. Recommend measures to converge and orchestrate internal security operations efforts of civil authorities and agencies, military and police;
4. Apply moral suasion to and/or recommend sanctions against local chief executives who are giving material and political support to the insurgents;
5. Monitor the provision of livelihood and infrastructure development programs and projects in the remote rural and indigenous population areas to isolate them from the insurgents' ideological, political and organizational works;
6. Formulate a 3-year Peace & Order and Public Safety (POPS) Plan to be incorporated in the Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP);
7. Formulate and adopt an effective mechanism for the coordination, cooperation, and consultation involving the local executives, citizenry and law enforcement agencies under R.A. 6975, as amended, in the adoption of the Community and Service Oriented Policing (CSOP) System;
8. Create a Special Action Committee to address the immediate issues on peace and order and public safety, in case of emergencies;
9. Create a Technical Working Group (TWG) for the purpose of POPS planning, following the guidelines prescribed by the DILG on the tools and processes on POPS Planning;
10. Serve as the convergence mechanism to support the Comprehensive Local Integration Program (CLIP) Committee in its implementation, at the provincial and HUC POC level;
11. Perform all other functions assigned by law, the President or the NPOC.

Section 3. SECRETARIAT. The Municipal Local Government Operation Officer shall act as the Head Secretariat of the Council and shall be assisted in its duties and functions by the following regular personnel from the Office of the MPOC Chairperson:

Section 4. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE SECRETARIAT. The Secretariat shall perform the following functions:

1. Assist the Chairperson in the conduct of MPOC meetings;
2. Provide technical assistance in the performance of administrative and technical tasks of the MPOC;
3. Recommend and prepare MPOC agenda and other required documents during council meetings;
4. Prepare Resolutions of the council and the minutes of the meeting;
5. Prepare and submit semestral MPOC Accomplishment Report to the NPOC through the PPOC and RPOC Secretariats;
6. Prepare and submit quarterly MPOC Secretariat Accomplishment Report to the NPOC through the PPOC and RPOC Secretariats;
7. Monitor peace and order situation and submit a quarterly report to the NPOC through the PPOC and RPOC Secretariats;
8. Monitor functionality of the BPOC and submit annual Functionality Report
9. Provide technical support or assistance to activities related to CLIP, Regional Task Forces, and other programs concerned with peace and public safety of the municipality; and
10. Provide such other assistance as may be required by the council;

Section 5. MEETING. The MPOC shall convene every last Thursday of the quarter or on a date or time as maybe determined by the members. If for any unavoidable circumstances an MPOC member cannot attend a meeting, he can send an official representative who can speak for his office or sector

Section 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
