**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.08-2022**

**AN ORDER CREATING PINAMALAYAN ASF TASKFORCE AND TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG), PRESCRIBING THEIR ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE BANTAY ASF SA BARANGAY PROGRAM AT THE LOCAL LEVEL**

**WHEREAS**, African Swine Fever (ASF), a high impact transboundary animal disease (TAD), continues to affect the swine production sector of the Philippines with no vaccine and no known cure to date; resulting in an industry estimate of a 36% reduction of national swine inventory impacting both livelihood and agriculture economy;

**WHEREAS**, early reporting of animal-borne disease is vital for efficient and well-coordinated response and immediate implementation of control measures;

**WHEREAS**, successful control effort lies with strong collaboration between the Department of Agriculture, its relevant agencies, concerned Local Government Units (LGU), and stakeholders taking ownership of such program benefitting the farmers;

**WHEREAS**, DA Administrative Order No. 7 Series of 2021 Implementing Guidelines for the "Bantay ASF sa Barangay Program" was enacted for the intensified disease response of the Government against ASF, where the DA, academe, private stakeholders and swine industry experts provide technical and support services to empower LGUs in the implementation of the "BANTAY ASF SA BARANGAY" interventions at the farm and community levels;

**WHEREAS**, Section 6 of DA Administrative Order No. 7 Series of 2021 Implementing Guidelines for the "Bantay ASF sa Barangay Program" reiterates the strengthening and institutionalization of LGU Engagement in the implementation of the Bantay ASF Program;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, ARISTEO A. BALDOS, JR.**, Local Chief Executive of Municipality of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the creation of Pinamalayan ASF Task Force, prescribing their roles and responsibilities in the implementation of the Bantay ASF sa Barangay Program at the local level, as follows:

**Section 1. Creation of Pinamalayan ASF Task Force.** By virtue of DA AO No. 43 Series of 2020, an African Swine Fever (ASF) Task Force is hereby created in the Municipality of Pinamalayan, Province of Oriental Mindoro to implement the Bantay ASF sa Barangay "BABay ASF" Program involving several departments and agencies with the Office Municipal Agriculturist as the lead implementing agency.

**Section 2. Composition of Task Force ASF.** The Task Force shall be composed of the following:

**Section 4. FUNCTIONS OF LGU ASF TASK FORCE .** The main functions of the LGU ASF Task Force include but not limited to the following:

1. Main implementer of "BABay ASF" Program;
2. Formulate local issuances, ordinances and contingency plans for the ASF-related activities including quick response, disease investigation, surveillance, animal movement control, information and education and logistics to relevant agencies such as the National, Regional and Municipal ASF Task Force;
3. Conduct capability building activities;
4. Disseminate information, guidelines and memoranda to all stakeholders;
5. Regularly submit reports to the Local Chief Executive on the status of its activities;
6. Perform such other functions as may be deemed necessary for full and proper implementation of ASF prevention and control protocols within the municipality;

**Section 5. REGISTRATION AND DEPUTIZATION OF BIOSECURITY OFFICERS.** Resident Veterinarians or Veterinary Consultants are herein recognized Veterinary as Biosecurity Officers (VetBO) upon their registration and deputization by the Municipal Veterinary Officer under the Municipal Agriculture Office.

Community/Village-Based Animal Technicians (CBAT), Barangay Animal Health Workers (BAHW), para-veterinary workers, Barangay Livestock Aide (BALA), volunteer veterinarians who are not residents of Pinamalayan or consulting veterinarians of any farm, or any person assigned/endorsed by the municipality to act as such and perform the duties and responsibilities concomitant to such assignment/endorsement.

To fast track the implementation of this provision the Municipal Agriculture Office is hereby mandated to oversee the efficient implementation of this provision and to issue a Biosecurity Officer Code to all concerned.

**Section 6. FUNDING.** Budgetary allocation for the implementation of this executive order shall be made available from the General Fund including training/capability building and other administrative costs.

**Section 7. EFFECTIVITY.** This order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until expressly revoked.
