EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.16-2022

AN ORDER AMENDING SECTIONS 2 AND 5 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 08-2022 entitled "AN ORDER CREATING PINAMALAYAN ASF TASKFORCE AND TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG), PRESCRIBING THEIR ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE BANTAY ASF SA BARANGAY PROGRAM AT THE LOCAL LEVEL"

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 08-2022 creating the Pinamalayan ASF Taskforce and Technical Working Group (TWG), prescribing their roles and responsibilities in the implementation of the Bantay ASF sa Barangay Program at the local level was issued on June 9, 2022;

WHEREAS, in compliance with Republic Act No. 7160 Article 3 Section 3, said executive order was indorsed to Provincial Governor's Office on June 10, 2022 for information and review;

WHEREAS, review and evaluation report of Provincial Legal Office (PLO) on the subject Executive Order was forwarded by the Provincial Governor's Office to the Municipal Government of Pinamalayan on August 4, 2022 for information and appropriate action.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ARISTEO A. BALDOS, JR., Local Chief Executive of Municipality of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro, in consideration of the findings and recommendations of the Provincial Legal Office, do hereby order the amendment of Sections 2 and 5 of Executive Order No. 08-2022, as follows:

Section 1. AMENDMENT ON SECTION 2 OF EO NO. 08-2022. Section 2 of Executive Order No. 08-2022 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Task Force may recommend additional members to the Local Chief Executive when it is deemed necessary.

Section 2. AMENDMENT ON SECTION 5 OF EO NO. 08-2022. Section 5 of Executive Order No. 08-2022 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 5. REGISTRATION AND DEPUTIZATION OF BIOSECURITY OFFICERS. All Veterinary Biosecurity Officers (VetBO) and Barangay Biosecurity Officers (BBOs) shall be registered and deputized by the Provincial Veterinary Office (PVO). VetBO shall apply directly to PVO, while BBO shall be assigned/endorsed by the Municipal Agriculture Office. VetBOs and BBOs shall undergo a one-day orientation and training as regards to their duties and responsibilities including the conduct of farm and area biosecurity evaluation and assessment, sample collection and weekly ASF negative monitoring report.

A certificate of training provided by Agricultural Training Institute-International Training Center on Pig Husbandry (ATI-ITCPH)/ Agricultural Training Institute - Regional Training Center (ATI-RTC) shall be issued as a proof that they have attended the training.

Biosecurity Officers must have their Biosecurity Officer Code to be issued by the PVO. For VetBO, registration may be online directly to the PVO, while for BBO, the Municipal Agriculture Office will endorse the list of registered BBO to be issued a Biosecurity Officer Code by the PVO.

To fast track the implementation of this activity, all existing networks of Animal Health Workers such as Barangay Animal Livestock Aide (BALA), Barangay Animal Health Workers (BAHW), and other similar barangay officials assigned to assist in the implementation of different animal health programmes is hereby designated as Barangay Biosecurity Officers (BBOs).

Barangay Captains in the areas where there are no Community/Village-Based Animal Technicians (CBATs) are hereby deputized as Barangay Biosecurity Officers (BBOs).”

Section 3. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately.
