EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 22- 2022

AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (MCPC) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 3344, as amended by Republic Act No. 10630, otherwise known as the "Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act", in reiterates the mandate of local government units (LGUs) to establish their respective Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPC), and to allocate at least 1% of their internal revenue allotment (IRA) for its strengthening;

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2021-039 entitled, "*Comprehensive Guidelines for the Establishment, Strengthening, and Monitoring of the Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPC) at all Levels and for Other Purposes*", dated 07 April 2021 mandates all local chief executives and Sanggunians at the provincial, city, municipal and barangay levels to organize/reorganize the LCPCs to assist the LGU in the identification, implementation, and monitoring of programs, projects and activities for the protection of children in their respective localities;

WHEREAS, to promote a child-friendly environment in the LGU, the Municipal Council for the Protection of Children (PCPC) shall be up to date to suit the needs of the children;

NOW THEREFORE, I, **ARISTEO A. BALDOS, JR.**, Municipal Mayor of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reconstitution of Municipal Council for the Protection of Children of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro as follows;

Section 1. COMPOSITION. The Municipal Council for the Protection of Children shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The MCPC shall perform the following duties and functions:

1. Formulate, develop, coordinate, monitor and review local policies (to include BCPC prepared and issued policies), ordinances, plans, programs, and activities which shall promote the best interest and rights of children and ensure mainstreaming in the local development agenda;
2. Prepare an Annual Work and Financial Plan (AWFP-LCPC WFP Form 001-B) consistent with its functions;
3. Establish, maintain and update a disaggregated database or local information system on all children within the city/municipality and shall include the information gathered by the BCPC;
4. Conduct advocacy activities on the promotion and protection of the rights and welfare of children including the development of information, education and advocacy materials;
5. Conduct capability-building activities for all stakeholders on children including in the barangay level;
6. Provide assistance to children in need of special protection;
7. Document good practice/s on children;
8. Coordinate and consult with other LCPCs, LGUs and other regional and national authorities with respect to policies and PPAs on Children;
9. Organize the necessary documents needed by the concerned IMTF; and
10. Conduct the Child-Friendly Local Governance Audit (CFLGA), through the LCPC Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force (IMTF), annually

Section 3. MCPC SECRETARIAT. The MCPC Secretariat shall be composed of the following:

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The Secretariat shall perform the following duties and functions:

1. Coordinate with LCPC members;
2. Prepare agenda for the LCPC;
3. Prepare minutes of the LCPC meeting;
4. Follow-through action points and agreements form the LCPC meetings;
5. Consolidate AWFPs of various departments related to LCPC plans;
6. Maintain and update relevant data/information/document of the Council; and
7. Monitor services and programs related to LCPC.

Section 4. MEETINGS AND ACTIONS BY THE MCPC. The MCPC shall have regular quarterly meetings, two special meetings for the CFLGA, and/or as the need arises. The meetings shall be presided by the Chair or the Vice-Chair. In the absence of both, the members present constituting a quorum shall elect among themselves the presiding officer with a majority vote.

Section 5. FUNDING. The LGU shall provide appropriate funds and administrative support necessary to defray expenses for the effective operation of the PCPC chargeable to 1% of IRA or LCPC Fund. Additional compensation and benefits shall NOT be given to the members of this council.

Section 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All executive issuances which are inconsistent with or contrary to the provision of this Executive Order are hereby repealed.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
