EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 48-2022

AN ORDER DECLARING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTION OF BONIFACIO AND DEL PILAR STREETS IN THE VICINITY OF THE MUNICIPAL PUBLIC MARKET TO ACCOMMODATE THE SELLING OF GOODS, MERCHANDISE, FOODSTUFFS, COMMODITIES AND OTHER SIMILAR ARTICLES OF COMMERCE ON DECEMBER 16-31, 2022

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, any municipality may temporarily close and regulate the use of any local street, road, thoroughfare, or public place where shopping malls, Sunday markets, flea or night markets, or shopping areas may be established and where goods, merchandise, foodstuff, commodities, or articles of commerce may be sold and dispensed to the general public;

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 56 of Municipal Ordinance No. 13-2020 otherwise known as the Pinamalayan Traffic Management and Enforcement Code authorizes the Local Chief Executive to temporary close roads any municipal roads/streets, thoroughfares or any public place for the purposes of establishing shopping stalls, Sunday flea or night markets or tiange, Christmas Bazar and Baraklan;

WHEREAS, the local market vendors requested for the conduct of "tiange" during holiday season at the portion of Bonifacio and Del Pilar Street;

WHEREAS, it has been customary in the Municipality of Pinamalayan to utilize the portion of the aforementioned streets for the holiday season as temporary shopping areas to the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ARISTEO A. BALDOS, JR, Local Chief Executive of the Municipality of Pinamalayan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby order the temporary closure of portion of Bonifacio and Del Pilar Street in the vicinity of the Municipal Public Market to accommodate the selling of goods merchandise, foodstuffs, commodities and other similar articles of commerce on December 16-31, 2022.

SECTION 1. SCOPE. The left portion of Bonifacio Street going South, from Buenas Glassware to Food Terminal and Del Pilar Street from Juan Luna Street in front of Blanco Trading to corner Morente Street and from Blanco Trading to corner Bonifacio in the vicinity of Pinamalayan Public Market shall be closed to accommodate the selling of goods, merchandise, foodstuffs, commodities and other similar articles of commerce

Section 2. DURATION. The temporary closure for Bonifacio Street (from Buenas Glassware to Food Terminal) and Del Pilar Street (from Juan Luna Street to Morente Street) shall take effect on December 24 and 31, 2022 only while in Del Pilar Street (from Blanco Trading to corner Bonifacio) closure will be on December 16-31,2022.

SECTION 3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The following terms and conditions shall be implemented:

- a. That a substitute route with corresponding routing plan shall be provided;
- b. That the alternate route shall be properly maintained for public safety until such duration that the subject road will be opened back to the public;
- c. That the residents of the area covered by the closure of road shall be given access;

- d. That all relevant laws and department orders appertaining temporary closure of roads and its guidelines shall be strictly followed.

SECTION 4. SUPERVISION. The Market Operations Department (MOD) shall take charge of the public announcement informing the public that the aforementioned roads are subject to temporary closure from December 16-31, 2022.

The Traffic Management Office (TMO) shall render assistance to MOD for traffic planning, controlling and directing traffic in the vicinity of Public Market.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
