EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 11-2025

AN ORDER INSTITUTIONALIZING THE SEAL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE FOR BARANGAY (SGLGB) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PINAMALAYAN, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO, AND PROVIDING FOR ITS IMPLEMENTATION GUIDELINES

WHEREAS, it is hereby declared the policy of the State to recognize the good performance of local government units (LGUs) in transparency and accountability in the use of public funds, preparedness for challenges posed by disasters, sensitivity to the needs of vulnerable and marginalized sectors of society, implementation of health programs, investment and employment promotion, protection of constituency from threats to life and damage to property, and safeguarding the integrity of the environment. In such recognition, the State hopes to encourage all LGUs to take on greater challenges, encourage outcome-based performance and to reward local governments for their effort in pursuing the general welfare of their constituency and in enforcing existing laws;

WHEREAS, the Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLGB) which has established pursuant to the preceding and institutionalized under DILG Memorandum circular No. 2023-103 dated July 28, 2023, is a performance assessment and recognition system that aims to give distinction to barangays with remarkable performance across various government area;

WHEREAS, the SGLGB and its results shall serve as one of the bases for the development of capacity development interventions, pursuant to DILG MC No. 2021-067, "Adoption of a Capacity Development Framework in the Planning Design, and Implementation for LGUs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ARISTEO A. BALDOS, JR., Municipal Mayor of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order:

Section 1. Institutionalization of the Seal of Good Local Governance for Barangay.

Pursuant to Republic Act 11292 otherwise known as "An Act Establishing and Institutionalizing the Seal of Good Local Governance for Local Government Units and Allocating Funds for This Purpose the Seal of Good Local Governance Fund", and DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2024-068 on the Implementation of the Seal of Good Local Governance for Barangay, this municipality hereby declares the institutionalization of the Seal of Good Local Governance for Barangay. The municipality shall grant awards and incentive programs to all barangays that will successfully pass the SGLGB criteria. The basis of the award shall be the latest criteria and indicators of the SGLGB set forth by the Department of the Interior and Local Government. However, the LGU is not precluded from adding rider indicators for the purpose of tailor fitting the SGLGB with the local needs and conditions.

Section 2. SGLGB Implementation Mechanisms. The following mechanisms shall govern the implementation of the SGLGB, to wit:

1. The Office of the Municipal Mayor shall organize the SGLGB Council. The Council shall act as an advisory body to ensure the proper implementation of the SGLGB consistent with existing DILG issuances and shall be composed of the following:

2. There shall be an SGLGB Assessment Team/ Assessor that will be in charge of assessing all barangays based on the given guidelines and criteria. The Assessor/ Assessment Team composition shall be based on the latest issuance of the DILG. The Office of the Mayor shall designate personnel to act as Secretariat and assist the SGLGB assessor/ team.
3. There shall be an annual SGLGB assessment which shall follow the schedule set forth by the DILG and the most recent guidelines subject to amendments by the DILG. The results of which shall be presented to the SGLGB Council as basis for policy formulation/ improvement.
4. There shall be an annual monitoring and evaluation of the SGLGB implementation to ensure its smooth implementation and to identify areas that need intervention from the barangay government, municipal government, partner CSOs, and other stakeholders. The monitoring and evaluation team shall be composed of the following:

5. The awarding ceremony shall be held annually on the date to be determined by the Office of the Mayor in coordination with the Office of the MLGOO, Liga ng mga Barangay, and shall be facilitated by the said offices.

Section 3. Requisites to Qualify for the SGLGB. The SGLGB criteria shall be the following subject to the annual guidelines set forth by the DILG:

- A. **Core Governance Areas-** These are the foundational indicators that ensure good governance particularly in delivering essential public services. They assess the effectiveness of key programs and projects in terms of financial accountability, peace and order, and protection of life and property.
 1. **Financial Administration and Sustainability-** This pertains to a barangay's outstanding practice of accountability and transparency in financial administration by adhering with accounting and auditing standards.
 2. **Disaster Preparedness-** This refers to a barangay's proactive measures, including the development and implementation of disaster risk reduction and management programs.
 3. **Safety, Peace and Order-** This represents a barangay's outstanding performance in maintaining peace and order through activities and support mechanisms that protect constituents from threats to life, health, and security.
- B. **Essential Governance Areas-** These indicators encompass providing basic social services, promoting business and income-generating activities, and safeguarding the environment.
 1. **Social Protection and Sensitivity-** This encompasses a barangay's responsiveness to the needs of disadvantaged/challenged sectors and the provision of support for basic education, food security, access to social welfare services, and participation in local special bodies.
 2. **Business-Friendliness and Competitiveness-** This reflects a barangay's notable efforts in promoting business and employment through supportive systems, structures, and legislation.
 3. **Environmental Management-** This refers to a barangay's conscientious preservation of the environment by complying with the provisions of the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000.

The SGLGB implementation shall adopt the "3+1" principle where the barangay needs to pass all the THREE (3) core governance areas and at least ONE (1) of the essential governance areas.

Section 4. Incentive Fund. There is hereby created a special account under the General Fund called "SGLGB Fund" with an initial allocation to be determined by this office in coordination with the Local Finance Committee, and subject to the availability thereof and the accounting and auditing rules and regulation. The utilization of the incentive fund shall be governed by the rules and regulations to be issued by the municipal government.

Section 5. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, all other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 6. Repealing Clause. All executive orders and other local issuances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon approval.
