EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 01-2026

AN ORDER DESIGNATING MS. AMAFE C. LOZANO, RN, NURSE III, AS THE MUNICIPAL POPULATION OFFICER (MPO) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) mandates local government units to promote the general welfare of their constituents and ensure the delivery of basic health and social services;

WHEREAS, the Commission on Population and Development (CPD) requires the institutionalization and effective implementation of Population and Development (PopDev), Responsible Parenthood and Family Planning (RFPF), Adolescent Health and Development (AHD), and other related programs at the local level;

WHEREAS, there is a need to designate a Municipal Population Officer to ensure the proper planning, coordination, implementation, monitoring, and reporting of population programs in the Municipality of Pinamalayan;

WHEREAS, Ms. Amafe C. Lozano, RN, Nurse III, is qualified and competent to perform the duties and responsibilities of a Municipal Population Officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RODOLFO M. MAGSINO, Local Chief Executive of the Municipality of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1: DESIGNATION. Ms. Amafe C. Lozano, RN, Nurse III, is hereby designated as the Municipal Population Officer (MPO) of the Municipality of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro.


SECTION 2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The Municipal Population Officer shall perform the following duties and functions:

- a. Plan, coordinate, and oversee the implementation of Population and Development, Responsible Parenthood and Family Planning, Adolescent Health and Development, and related programs in the municipality;
- b. Serve as the focal person and official liaison with the Commission on Population and Development and other concerned agencies;
- c. Prepare and submit required plans, reports, and data relative to population programs;
- d. Coordinate with barangays, national government agencies, and other stakeholders for the effective implementation of population-related activities; and
- e. Perform such other duties and functions as may be assigned by the Municipal Mayor.

SECTION 3: SUPERVISION. The Municipal Population Officer shall be under the direct supervision of the Municipal Health Officer, through the Municipal Health Office, for purposes of program coordination and implementation.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing.
