EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 062-2025

AN ORDER EXTENDING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A PORTION OF JAENA STREET FOR THE CONTINUED HOLDING OF THE BAHAGHARI FOOD BAZAAR IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO UNTIL JANUARY 4, 2026

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 054-2025 was issued directing the temporary closure of a portion of Jaena Street, from corner Madrid Blvd. to corner Mabini Street, for the conduct of the Bahaghari Food Bazaar from December 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025;

WHEREAS, paragraph (c), Section 21 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the *Local Government Code of 1991*, authorizes the Local Chief Executive to temporarily close any national or local road, alley, park, or square during fiesta celebrations, agricultural or industrial fairs, the duration of which shall be specified in a written order;

WHEREAS, paragraph (d) of the same law further provides that local streets and public places may be temporarily closed and regulated for the establishment of shopping areas, flea or night markets, and other similar commercial activities through appropriate executive action;

WHEREAS, Section 56 of Municipal Ordinance No. 13-2020, otherwise known as the *Pinamalayan Traffic Management and Enforcement Code of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro*, authorizes the Local Chief Executive to temporarily close municipal roads or streets for shopping stalls, bazaars, tiangge, and other cultural, civic, and economic activities;

WHEREAS, the vendors participating in the Bahaghari Food Bazaar have formally requested the extension of its operation beyond December 31, 2025 to further promote local entrepreneurship, livelihood opportunities, and economic activity within the municipality;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Pinamalayan finds the request to be reasonable and consistent with its objective of sustaining local economic development and supporting small-scale vendors;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RODOLFO M. MAGSINO, Local Chief Executive of the Municipality of Pinamalayan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the extension of the temporary closure of a portion of Jaena Street for the continued holding of the Bahaghari Food Bazaar, as follows:

Section 1. EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY CLOSURE. The temporary closure of Jaena Street, both sides from corner Madrid Blvd. to corner Mabini Street, for the conduct of the Bahaghari Food Bazaar is hereby **EXTENDED**.

Section 2. DURATION. The extension shall take effect **from January 1, 2026 until January 4, 2026**, unless earlier lifted or further extended by subsequent issuance.

Section 3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS. All terms and conditions stipulated under Executive Order No. 054-2025 shall remain in full force and effect, including but not limited to the following:

- a) That a substitute route with a corresponding routing plan shall be provided;
- b) That the alternate route shall be properly maintained to ensure public safety during the period of closure;
- c) That residents within the affected area shall be granted proper access; and
- d) That all relevant laws, ordinances, and department orders governing the temporary closure of roads shall be strictly observed.

Section 4. SUPERVISION AND IMPLEMENTATION. The Tourism and History Development Division (THDD) shall continue to take charge of public announcements informing the public of the extended temporary closure, specifying the dates and duration thereof.

The Traffic Management Office (TMO), in coordination with the Pinamalayan Municipal Police Station, shall continue to provide assistance in traffic planning, control, and other traffic management-related concerns.

Section 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All executive issuances, rules, or regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
