EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 017-2026

AN ORDER DIRECTING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN ROADS AND STREETS IN CONNECTION WITH THE CELEBRATION OF THE 110TH FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY AND 27TH BAHAGHARI FESTIVAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO

WHEREAS, paragraph c of Section 21 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", provides that any national or local road, alley, park, or square may be temporarily closed during fiesta celebrations, agricultural or industrial fairs, the duration of which shall be specified by the local chief executive concerned in a written order;

WHEREAS, paragraph d of the aforesaid law states that any municipality, through a duly enacted ordinance may temporarily close and regulate the use of any local street, road, thoroughfare, or any other public place where shopping malls, Sunday, flea or night markets, or shopping areas may be established and where goods, merchandise, foodstuffs, commodities, or articles of commerce may be sold and dispensed to the general public;

WHEREAS, Section 56 of Municipal Ordinance No. 13-2020 or the Pinamalayan Traffic Management and Enforcement Code of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro authorizes the Local Chief Executive to temporarily close any municipal roads/streets, thoroughfares or any public place for the purposes of establishing shopping stalls, Sunday flea or night markets or tiangge, Christmas bazar and baraklan and during the celebration of local and national holidays and conduct of cultural, civic and religious activities;

WHEREAS, in connection with the forthcoming Town Fiesta Celebration, a series of official activities have been duly approved and scheduled, including but not limited to nightly cultural and entertainment programs, concerts, variety shows, and the Grand Parade of Colors, which are expected to generate significant public attendance and vehicular and pedestrian traffic;

WHEREAS, the temporary closure of certain roads and streets within the Municipality is deemed necessary and indispensable to ensure public safety and convenience, prevent traffic congestion and related hazards, maintain peace and order, and facilitate the orderly, efficient, and uninterrupted conduct of the aforementioned activities, as well as to provide adequate space for pedestrian movement, crowd control, and the proper deployment of security, emergency, and traffic management personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RODOLFO M. MAGSINO, Municipal Mayor of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. SCOPE AND PURPOSE. In order to ensure public safety, maintain orderly conduct of activities, and provide adequate space for the implementation of various events, the following roads and streets shall be temporarily closed to vehicular traffic:

A. April 21–24, 2026 (1:00 PM – 12:00 Midnight)

- Portion of Madrid Boulevard from corner Leuterio Street to corner Jaena Street

Purpose: Nightly Fiesta Activities at the Open Auditorium

B. April 23–24, 2026 (1:00 PM of April 23 to 1:00 AM of April 24)

- Portion of Mabini Street from Rural Bank of Pola corner Jaena Street to Alliance Gasoline Station corner Leuterio Street

Purpose: Preparatory activities for the launching of Fontana de Gobernador/Spongecola Concert

C. April 25, 2026 (1:00 PM onwards)

- Portion of Mabini Street from Octagon to Municipal Engineering Office
- Portion of Quezon Street corner Madrid Boulevard and Mabini Street
- Portion of Manrique Street corner Madrid Boulevard and Mabini Street

Purpose: Grand Fiesta Variety Show at Pilot School and Grand Parade of Colors

D. April 25, 2026 (2:00 PM to 6:00 PM)

- Portion of Madrid Boulevard (left lane only if facing Recodo Port) from in front of the Municipal Government Complex to Recodo Area
- Malvar Street corner Madrid Boulevard and Mabini Street
- Mabini Street from Card Bank to corner Burgos Street

E. April 29, 2026 (4:00 PM to 11:00 PM)

- Right lane of Madrid Blvd. (if facing Recodo Port) from in front of IBSMA Gymnasium to Recodo Port Area

Purpose: Blockings Rehearsal of Pandang Gitab Street Dancing Contingents

F. April 30, 2026 (3:00 PM to 10:00 PM)

- Right lane of Madrid Blvd (if facing Recodo Port) from in front of IBSMA Gymnasium to Recodo Port Area

❖ 2-Way traffic from IBSMA Gymnasium to Recodo Port Area

G. May 01, 2026 (3:00 PM to 10:00 PM)

Purpose: Oriental Mindoro's Pandang Gitab: The Festival of Lights Street Dancing Competition

Section 2. DURATION. The temporary closure of the above-mentioned roads shall be effective only on the dates and times specified herein, unless sooner lifted or extended as may be necessary.

Section 3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The following terms and conditions shall be implemented:

- a. That a substitute route with corresponding routing plan shall be provided;
- b. That the alternate route shall be properly maintained for public safety until such duration that the subject road will be opened back to the public;
- c. That the residents of the area covered by the closure of road shall be given access;
- d. That all relevant laws and department orders appertaining temporary closure of roads and its guidelines shall be strictly followed.

For this purpose, the herein attached Vicinity Map shall form an integral part of this Order.

Section 4. SUPERVISION AND IMPLEMENTATION. The Traffic Management Office (TMO), Pinamalayan Municipal Police Station, Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO), and Municipal Engineering Office are hereby directed to:

- Implement traffic rerouting and control measures;
- Install appropriate traffic signage and barriers;
- Ensure safety, security, and order during the duration of the road closures.

The Public Information Office (PIO) shall ensure wide dissemination of this Order to properly inform the public.

Section 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
